

YOUNG COMPOSERS COMPETITION 2025/26

The Etobicoke Philharmonic Orchestra, located in the City of Toronto, Ontario, invites submissions for its eighth Young Composers Competition.

Grand Prize: \$2,500, plus a performance of the winning

Composition at a future EPO concert

Runner-Up: \$1,500

Promising High-School Composer: \$500

DEADLINE:

Submissions must be received by 6:00 pm on November 3, 2025.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. Composers must be 32 years or under on December 31, 2025.
- 2. The competition is open to Canadian citizens and permanent residents. Proof of status will be required for winning entries.
- 3. Works must be original compositions and ten minutes or less in duration.
- 4. Works must be scored for orchestra with 2222/4231, timp, perc, strings. Picc, 3rd flute and 3rd trumpet are optional.
- 5. Promising High-School Composer entries may be considered for the Grand Prize and Runner-Up, at the judges' discretion.
- 6. Composers may not submit more than one score.

ASSESSMENT: Entries will be assessed by a panel of three judges: Penelope Walcott - composer, sound designer and sound artist Matthew Jones – Music Director, Etobicoke Philharmonic Orchestra Mark Whale – Concertmaster, Etobicoke Philharmonic Orchestra

HOW TO APPLY: E-mail a completed application form (available at www. eporchestra.ca) to **youngcomposers@eporchestra.ca**. Attach the score as .pdf file, and include a link to an audio file if you choose to submit a recording. Submissions that include recordings (orchestral or MIDI-synthesized) are generally easier to assess.

Include only the name of the composition on the score and in the .pdf/audio filenames. Do not include the composer's name.
